Taxable income is all wages, salaries and other compensation paid to an individual for work or services performed prior to deduction of any kind (except Section 125 deductions), the net profits from any business or profession located inside the Village of Mt. Orab or conducting business inside Mt. Orab and/or the net profits from the rental of real estate property. Military income is not subject to Mt. Orab tax.

Income

- Line 1 Add Total Taxable Wages from all W-2 and 1099-Misc forms and enter total on Line 1. Use the larger amount from Box 18, Box 5, or Box 1 from each W-2 form whichever amount is larger. Income received from Social Security, retirement, interest income, disability or similar non-employment income is not subject to the Mt. Orab Income Tax. INCLUDE ALL W-2 AND 1099 FORMS WITH RETURN.
- Line 2 Enter the additional net taxable income from Line 27, Page 2. Note: Losses from business and rental activities cannot be used to reduce taxable wages reported on W-2 forms, but can be used to offset other business forms or carried forward up to five (5) years.
- Line 3 Add amounts on Line 1 and Line 2 and enter on Line 3.

Tax and Credits

- Line 4 Multiply amount on Line 3 times tax rate of 1.35% (.0135) and enter amount on Line 4.
- Line 5 Enter the amount of estimated tax paid directly to Mt. Orab during 2022 for your 2022 tax liability. Do not include any payments made in 2022 that were for the balance due for 2021 (or any other previous year).
- Line 6 Enter the amount of Tax withheld for the Village of Mt. Orab in 2022 by your employers. If the city indicated in Box 20 of a W-2 form indicates Mt. Orab, enter the total amount indicated in Box 19 from each appropriate W-2 form.
- Line 7 Indicate any overpayment from your 2021 tax return that was credited to 2022.
